**About Us**

Pro-Choice Missouri (Pro-Choice MO) is the leading grassroots pro-choice advocacy organization in Missouri. We work to protect every person's right to access the full range of reproductive health options, including but not limited to preventive care, family planning, sexuality education, prenatal and postnatal health care, and accessible, legal abortion.

Pro-Choice MO is dedicated to building and sustaining a constituency that uses the political process to guarantee reproductive health, rights, and justice for every Missourian.

**Position Description**

Pro-Choice Missouri is seeking a Kansas City Project Organizer to grow our statewide presence to Kansas City. This is an entry level organizer position well-suited for someone seeking to learn the basics of grassroots organizing, including basebuilding, voter engagement through canvassing and phonebanking, and leadership development. The project organizer will be tasked with building a base of Pro-Choice Missouri members in Kansas City to participate in volunteer activities including canvassing, phonebanking, and community meetings. The Project Organizer will also be tasked with building trusting relationships with local organizations and community leaders through regular 1on1s. To support their development, the Project Organizer will be paired with a skilled organizing coach to help them develop their skills. This position will go through the end of 2022 with opportunities for renewal in the new year.

**Organizer Responsibilities:**

- Develop strong conversations with KC area supporters and move them to participate in voter engagement activities
- Run weekly canvasses and fill canvassing shifts for GOTV (Get Out The Vote)
- Develop Kansas City organizing committee of Pro-Choice Missouri volunteers
- Set weekly organizing goals and create plans to achieve them with support of organizing coach
- Hold 1on1s to develop trust and strong relationships with Pro-Choice Missouri supporters and local community leaders
- Review results from canvasses using VAN and Google Forms and report them back to organizing director on a weekly basis

**Ideal candidate will possess the following qualities and skills:**

- Strong commitment to reproductive rights and justice
- A deep desire to see transformational change in Missouri
- A strong work ethic and ability to work independently
- A deep desire to learn basics of grassroots organizing.
- Willingness to receive and incorporate feedback
- Familiarity with political environment and community in Missouri
- Experience planning and conducting trainings and facilitating meetings
- Excellent oral and written communication skills

- Ability to work some irregular hours. This position will require some night and weekend work.
- Exceptional organizational skills, attention to detail and strategic thinking
- Ability to independently manage several projects at one time, set priorities and follow a strategic plan
- Flexibility in work environment
- Ability to communicate effectively and to build positive relationships with staff, volunteers, board members, and Pro-Choice Missouri membership

**Position Benefits**

This is a full-time, temporary, benefit exempt position. The Project Organizer will be paid \$4,500/month.
